Our music department has the opportunity to perform at the prestigious Heritage Music Festival in Vancouver BC 2024!! Jackson High School music programs have one many awards at the competitive event.

Please take note of the following information:

- Trips are **not** required for this class and non-participation will not affect a student's grade.
- In order to commit to this trip, **we must receive enough contracts and deposits to ensure a balanced, quality music performing group.**
- **In order for this trip to happen, all families need to engage with the Mattress Fundraiser, February 24th.** Proceeds earned from the Mattress Fundraiser could potentially lower the cost for everyone.
- The trip cost includes \$100 to cover the cost of House Bill 1660, which enables all students to participate. This amount could be adjusted depending on final registration numbers and the success of the Mattress Fundraiser, February 24th.
- Students will miss 1 day of school and are responsible for completing all work required for classes.
- Students who are unable to meet behavior standards in the classroom and in school in general, will not be permitted to travel with the choir and orchestra.
- Students must have proper documentation to cross the border.

BORDER CROSSING INFORMATION

Students, under 19, should use a valid U.S. Passport, which will not expire until 6 months after the trip, or appropriate immigration documentation or a certified copy of their birth certificate and photo ID. Please check All chaperones must have a valid U.S. Passport or enhanced ID as their form of identification. Anyone without proper identification will be turned away at the border. Adults MUST carry their U.S. Passport with them at all times.

Please make sure you have all the required documentation for your child to cross the border before making a commitment to this trip.

REGISTRATION

WORLDSTRIDES

To successfully complete the required online registration process:

1. Visit our website at: worldstrides.com/register
2. Enter your Trip ID:213080
3. Click "REGISTER"
4. Verify the School Name and Teacher Name(listed as Michael Lundquist), then select Student or Adult.
5. Enter all requested information.
6. Read the Terms & Conditions and click Accept. Here you will have the option to download or print for your records.
7. Submit your completed form.

*Please note student registrations should be completed by a parent or guardian as Terms and Conditions must be agreed to in the process.

CANCELLATIONS

Refer to the refund schedule above. The sole exception is that an eligible student can "buy out" your spot if you need to cancel, provided they can be accommodated in available rooming options. If a buy-out isn't feasible, all trip costs become the responsibility of the legal parent/guardian who signed the initial contract, covering both paid and incurred expenses on the student's behalf. Any fees for hotel name-changes resulting from a student buy-out are the responsibility of the parent/guardian of the student being added and must be paid before purchasing new tickets. No verbal changes or cancellations are accepted; written cancellations require a dated and signed letter from the parent/guardian.

STATEMENT REGARDING NON-REFUNDABLE EXPENSES

Certain advance payments for trips or competitions are non-refundable. When the school incurs non-refundable expenses on behalf of the students, the commitment to participate implies an agreement to cover your student's portion of these costs, even if unforeseen circumstances prevent participation later.

If you've paid for a non-refundable expense, no refunds are possible, as the school cannot retrieve the funds from the company. If you haven't paid but the school has covered your non-refundable expense based on your commitment, you'll incur a fine on your account.

Please sign and return this CONTRACT with the deposit RECEIPT stapled to it to Mrs. West, Mr. Schell or Mr. Lundquist no later than 2:15 on January 31, 2024.

By signing this agreement, I/we commit to the following conditions for participation in the JHS Choir, Orchestra & Band trip to Vancouver BC:

- Acceptance of the financial terms outlined in this agreement.
- Acknowledgment and agreement to all terms and conditions in the JHS Music Vancouver Trip Behavior and Expectations Google Form.
- Completion of this form and all accompanying documents.
- Parent or guardian signature on permission slips, even if the student is 18.
- Registration with World Strides as per the instructions in this packet.
- Acknowledgment that disciplinary, academic, or other issues may result in the family being responsible for non-refundable fees.
- Understanding that failure to possess proper border-crossing documentation will lead to the forfeiture of all paid fees, and the student will be denied boarding.

Traveling with the choir/orchestra/band is a privilege. Clear communication on trip cancellations is crucial; all cancellations must be in writing to be valid—verbal requests won't be honored by the travel company. If you cancel, all non-refundable fees, whether paid or not, will be charged. Stay informed about performance details, clinic times, and the finalized itinerary by checking emails and discussing updates with your student.
