- Why do we do the Diagnostic?
 - The diagnostic helps us to find out what students know and understand what they still need to learn.
 - It is important for the students to do the work on their own and do their best!
- It is important to:
 - o Read each question and answer choice carefully
 - Use scratch paper or whiteboard to show your work
- The assessment is adaptive.
 - This means that questions will get easier or more difficult based on how students answered earlier questions.
 - Students will see questions they're unfamiliar with and that is okay!
